# Day 1 - TUESDAY MAY 7 - DEPARTURE TO VICTORIA D meet as a group at the school 7:00am for the safety of others, and for your convenience, consider bringing a mask in case you are feeling unwell at anytime during the tour - 1 – 56 passenger coach from Thompson Valley Charters arrives for loading of luggage and 7:30am equipment and boarding of passengers Note: additional passengers travelling by separate van arranged by the school - a motorcoach safety briefing including the use of seat belts when available, will be completed prior to departure (always use seat belts when available and locate the emergency exits if your coach changes during your tour) - board your coach and depart for **Tsawwassen Ferry Terminal** (drive time est. 5 hours plus extra 8:00am time for traffic) - check in with **BC Ferries** 1:30pm group must check in no later than 30 mins prior to scheduled sailing departure purchase lunch at the ferry terminal or on board the ferry 2:00pm scheduled departure on **BC Ferries** from **Tsawwassen to Swartz Bay** 3:35pm scheduled arrival at Swartz Bay Ferry Terminal - depart to the **Holiday Inn Express Colwood** (drive time est. 1 hour) 4:35pm arrive and check in for 3 nights note: you will have a late lunch tomorrow so ensure you have snacks to bring with you - locally chartered 56-passenger coach from Wilson's Coach Lines arrives for boarding - depart to Langford Lanes - arrive for 2 hours of bowling and pizza dinner event ends; board your coach depart back to your hotel arrive and retire to your rooms 9:30pm Day 2 - WEDNESDAY MAY 8 - VICTORIA B/D 6:30am - continental breakfast buffet included at the hotel (served 6:30am to 9:30am daily) 7:30am - load coach with instruments and board
